ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

Let us all rejoice in the Lord, for our Saviour has been born in the world. Today true peace has come down to us from heaven.

FIRST READING Isaiah 9:1-7

PSALM Psalm 95

RESPONSE: Today a saviour has been born to us; he is Christ the Lord.

- O sing a new song to the Lord, sing to the Lord all the earth.

- Proclaim his help day by day, tell among the nations his glory and his wonders among all the peoples. R.

- The Lord has made known his salvation; has shown his justice to the nations. He has remembered his truth and love for the house of Israel. R.
- All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. Shout to the Lord all the earth, ring out your joy. R.
- Sing psalms to the Lord with the harp, with the sound of music.
 With trumpets and the sound of the horn acclaim the King, the Lord. R.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION Alleluia, alleluia! A hallowed day has dawned upon us. Come, you nations, worship the Lord, for today a great light has shone down upon the earth. Alleluia!

GOSPEL John 1:1-18
